EUROPEAN TEACHING FELLOWS MEETING
Tuesday, 9 August 1988
ISNIP Conference, Sweden

Ingemar Arn, Magda Baukeland, Peter Geerlings, Jeff Gordon, Gunvor Gustafsson, Inger Johansson, Tage Johansson, Alix Kremer, Asa Lööf, Johan Maertens, Elsie Pettersson, and Nimet Salem attended the meeting.

Jeff Gordon agreed to chair the meeting, Alix Kremer agreed to take minutes.

Ingemar Arn's application as Teaching Fellow had been delegated to the European Teaching Fellows from ISNIP. It had already been discussed at the European Meeting in Germany where Johan had raised some concerns which he was able to resolve after discussing them with Ingemar. We agreed to vote by secret ballot. Asa reported that she had Martien Kooyman's proxy. Peter counted the votes: 11 yes, 1 abstention, 0 no in favor of accepting Ingemar as a Teaching Fellow.

We shared some information and concerns about Chris Königs and recommended to the Swedish Society that they refer his request for membership to the Dutch-Flemish Society.

We shared some views and questions about the possibility of an American Society being founded.

We agreed to be prepared to discuss Criteria for Teaching Fellow status by Friday morning.

Jeff adjourned the meeting.
