1. CRITERIA FOR FELLOW (v. annex 1)

The general opinion of the meeting is that the training as a NIP therapist is to be seen as an advanced or specialised training for individuals who have a basic training in psychotherapy.

2. CRITERIA FOR TEACHING FELLOW (v. annex 2)

The question of exceptions (introduction of the method in a country, training of a well trained therapist...) is postponed to a later phase.

3. PROCEDURE (v. annex 3)

Later we must divide the criteria (what does the applicant has to do) from the procedure (how it procedes).
