Get ready! It's coming! The Seventh Annual ISNIP Conference to be held June 22-26, 1989, in New Haven, CT.

- Preparations have been underway for months to ensure a successful conference for all attendees. What is also necessary for this conference's success is your participation.
- All attending Teaching Fellows are **strongly urged** to present during the conference. Your abstracts need to be in to Ron Kissick by Jan. 31! (Ron's address is in the Society Calendar listing and membership listing).
- Take advantage of the pre-conference workshop to be held June 18-21. The \$300 fee includes a full 3 days of workshops, breakfasts and lunches and dorm-style lodging for 3 nights. Remember — if you attend the workshop, you must make an extra-night's reservation at the hotel (Wed.) after the workshop's completion.
- The hotel registration card needs to be filled out and sent (along with check) directly to the hotel. The other fees on the application (pre-conference, conference and banquet) get sent to Yetta Lautenschlager whose address is on the application.

Research Update

At the conference in Sweden two important decisions were made:

1. There is a need to make all kinds of publications more available. Therefore we are constructing a bibliography with books and articles that are relevant for the New Identity Process. We include our first list. We would like to complete this list, so you can send us all articles about NIP in any language. We plan to make an up-to-date list quarterly. People that are interested in an article can obtain it from us at cost-price.

2. Concerning the research project; one of the difficulties we had in the construction of a guide for completing the registration forms, was that there were no operational definitions. In the future this problem will be solved because there is a committee installed, headed by Peter Geerlings, that will work on the development of a theoretical framework. Another committee, headed by George Rynick will work on a manual (description of the method). The coordination will be done by Johan Maertens.

The Clients: What Do They Think About The NIP?

As part of my training to become a psychologist at the University of Gothenburg, I got the opportunity to do some research. What appealed to me most was getting a grasp of the general views of former NIP clients and opinions about their own therapeutic processes. Consequently a questionnaire was constructed and mailed to over 100 former NIP clients in Sweden.

I focused my interest upon three specific areas:

1. What were the characteristics of the people taking part in the NIP group? (Sex, age, profession, types of problems, etc.)
2. What did they think of the NIP in general and what was the outcome?
3. What did they find essential in the therapeutic process?

The population was defined as people who had been regularly in groups during at least one year and who had finished their NIP between 1979 and 1986. A total of 138 fulfilled the requirements. Ten of them were however impossible to reach and 3 declared that they did not want to take part in the inquiry. Thus, 125 persons received a questionnaire and out of these 65% (81 persons) replied.

As of yet only question No. 2 from above has been fully dealt with and analyzed.

Some conclusions from the first part of the study are as follows: Most of the respondents feel that the NIP is a very valuable therapeutic method. The respondents have on the whole provided a very positive picture of the NIP, even though they were critical regarding certain aspects. The results indicate that most of them today experience a constructive personal change compared with the time before starting in the NIP group. Some of them have changed a great deal, others less. Still it is not possible to determine whether it is the NIP or possibly other factors which have brought about this change for the better.

A full report can be found in my paper "Forandring via identitetsterapi - Vad anser terapideltagarna?"/Changing through the NIP - What are the views of the clients? (Ingrid Svensson, 1987. Psykologiska Institutionen, Goteborgs Universitet). Unfortunately, for the time being the paper is only available in Swedish.
