The ISBP international conference will be organized by Fondazione Progetto Uomo.

Official inauguration will be organized on Friday, October 1st, at 3 pm, at Giovanni XXIII's Congress Center, in downtown Belluno, and can be attended by advanced registration.

The conference will present, during the week end, two parallel paths:

- a) One dedicated to Bonding Society members (ISBP) and interested people;
- b) One dedicated to FICT members (Therapeutic Communities) and operators.

The section dedicated to ISBP members will be held throughout the weekend and will be mainly located at Benito Hotel, Ponte nelle Alpi (BL).

The agenda presents lectures by a number of international psychology and therapeutic specialists, training sessions and experiential workshops.

Saturday, October the 2nd, at Giovanni XXIII's Congress Center, Belluno, the agenda presents a program of discussion groups, round tables and workshops, on Therapeutic Communities topics and training proposals from 9.30 am up to until 6 pm.

A community of emotions

ISBP and FICT, Bonding Psychotherapy and rehabilitation facilities, a tie that takes us back to the roots of this practice.

The root of Bonding Psychotherapy began at Synanon, the first rehabilitation facility, opened in California in 1958.

The founder, Charlie Dederich, together with other members, understood the need of a new method, one that centered around the group, creative and new.

In the group, participants were free to express, in total freedom, thoughts and emotions, as the ones that were now awake and rogue in their behaviors.

Expression and not action.

Communication and not retaliation.

Empathic approach and not menace.

Truly open and not manipulative.

Honesty of feelings and not cold calculations.

The effect was stunning, almost magical. People that were ready to fight, were now identifying themselves in an expressed emotion, ending up in hugs instead of aggression.

They felt relief and pleasure, a sense of belonging and the possibility of expressing their true colors, creating bonds, friendships, and a community.

Being together through all, even when individual situations arose.

The philosophy and method of BP hence have a full community spirit

ISBP and emotional psychotherapy in the world.

The International Society for Bonding Psychotherapy, is the organization that promotes, facilitates research and teaches the practice of Emotional Psychotherapy all around the globe

Founded in 1984, ISBP now has offices all around the world, including USA, Argentina, Germany, Belgium, the Netherlands, Sweden, Italy, Portugal and Slovenia. These offices carry the mission of teaching the practice of emotional therapy.

What about Italy? In Italy emotional psychotherapy is promoted and taught under the supervision of SIPE (Italian Society for Bonding Psychotherapy), “founded in 1987 by a group of operators coming from different environments and career paths, but all having the psychotherapeutic methodology interest of the method introduced by American psychoanalyst Daniel Casriel”. SIPE is affiliated with ESBP- European Society for Bonding Psychotherapy- an organization that, as a member of EAP (European Association of Psychotherapy), represents all therapists and members that practice BP.

FICT (*Federazione Italiana Comunità Terapeutiche*)

FICT (*Federazione Italiana Comunità Terapeutiche*) has now been working across the Italian territory and internationally for over thirty-five years, as a no profit non-profit organization. It is present in 16 out of 20 regions in Italy, divided in 42 associations and social solidarity entities, now providing over 600 services, over a wide range of services in addition to the rehab sector. It is presided by a presidency council, elected every 3 years by the board of members.

In the year 2000 it obtained the status of NGO from the United Nations, associated to the Department of Public Information and it collaborates with the World Federation of Therapeutic Communities (WFTC.)

FICT realizes projects and services nationwide, across the Mediterranean countries and in Latin America, in the field of international cooperation. It also focuses on local projects through Federation Centers.
